A shrink wrap cover is a great way to protect large items because it is heat shrunk. This means it moulds to the object it is protecting, becoming 'tight as a drum skin' and so it cannot flap or chafe, even at high wind speeds. This tightness is the secret of the strength and durability of shrink wrap.

Here are some examples of projects Shrink Wrap  $\operatorname{Pro}^{\mathsf{T}}$  has carried out over the years:

A radar tower in shannon 16 metres high and 12 metres square was encapsulated in February 2011 for grit blasting and painting.
